Microenvironmental System

Quick Start Guide

Adding the Davis Cup Anemometer to the current Decagon offerings makes possible a complete microenvironmental monitoring system. Please see your Em50 manual and other accompanying manuals for details about each instrument. Below are some guidelines for your system.

- 1. Select the location where you want to quantify the microenvironment, but keep in mind that nearby trees and buildings may affect your readings.
- **2.** Mount the sensors on a 1-3/4" OD pipe. A steel pipe can be set in concrete or, for a quick installation, PVC pipe can be placed over a T-post.
- **3.** Wind speed, temperature, and vapor pressure vary with height. Some standard calculations assume a specific height, such as 2m for these measurements.
- **4.** Mount the system so shadows are not artificially cast onto the sensing head.
- **5.** Use the leveling bubble on the rain gauge to level the system.
